Programmatic Infrastructure Checklist

Executive Leadership

Surgeon Leader: Medical Director or Program Director for Robotic Surgery

Executive Sponsor: CEO, COO, or CMO—an invested and contributing Executive Sponsor from the C-Suite

CFO or Financial Analyst: An invested and contributing institutional financial partner

Clinical Excellence

Surgeon lead from each specialty: Trained robotic surgeon who represents the needs and thoughts of each contributing service line

FT Robotics Coordinator: A dedicated full-time coordinator for the robotic-assisted surgery service line

Dedicated robotics team: CST, RN, CFA, etc.—fully invested, aligned, and well-trained clinical support team dedicated to the robotic-assisted surgery service line

Operational Excellence

Operational Leadership Sponsor: OR Director or Director of Perioperative Services

Dedicated Data Analyst: Hospital liaison who helps capture, organize, and communicate programmatic data for evidence-based strategy

Service Line Steering Committee: Meets quarterly, at a minimum

Anesthesia, M.D. Lead: A representative from the department of Anesthesia who supports the robotic-assisted surgery service line

SPD Sponsor: Reprocessing or Materials Manager who is invested and contributes to the robotic-assisted surgery service line
